**Section A - Fashion Days**

- Class 1. "Silk" A design in the Oriental Manner
- Class 2. "Lame" A Stretch Design
- Class 3. "Brocade" A Mass Design (European Period, Dutch and Flemish)

Designs in Section B, Classes 4, 5, 6 are eligible for the Designer's Choice Award  
The exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant material and other components.

**Section B - Play Days**

- Class 4. "Eyelet" A Transparency Desk
- Class 5. "Corduroy" A Creative Horizontal Design
- Class 6. "Oil Cloth" An Abstract Creative Design

Designs in Section C. Classes 7, 8 and 9 are eligible for the Award of Distinction  
All plant materials used in design must be dried.

**Section C - Work Days**

- Class 7. "Quilted Cotton" A Creative Mass Design
- Class 8. "Denim" A Tubular Design
- Class 9. "Burlap" An Enhanced Sculptural Form Design

Designs in Section D, Class 10 are reserved for Novice Arrangers (One who has never won a blue ribbon in the Design Division of a Standard Flower Show).

Type of plant material and other components are arranger's choice but NO container grown plants may be included.)
